Job Description:

- Provides personal care to patients
- Assists patients with bathing, grooming, toileting and elimination and adequate nutritional intake.
- Obtains vital signs
- Assists with transfers
- Helps with admission and discharges in hospitals and outpatient settings
- Maintains a safe and clean environment for patients
- Assists patients in their home with activities of daily living
- May assist with light housecleaning and grocery shopping
- Reminds patients to take current medications
- Reports signs and symptoms of distress to immediate supervisor
- Generally works directly under a registered nurse

- Hospitals
- Assisted Living Facilities
- Home Health Agencies
- Private Duty
