Job Description:

- Fills prescription drugs according to doctor's orders
- Measures out correct amount of medication into containers
- Prepares prescription labels.
- Enters Prescription and information into computer
- Reconstitutes oral liquids.
- Compounds bulk medications for dispensing
- Checks inventory and orders supplies
- Waits on customers
- Cleans work areas.
- Helps fill out insurance forms.
- Works directly under the supervision of a Pharmacist.

*Average Salary in Oklahoma:

- Yearly: \$15,100 to \$26,800
- Hourly: \$9.66/hr. (average)

*Base Salary in the Nation:

- Yearly: \$15,500 to \$32,900
- Hourly: \$10.70/hr. (average)

Education and Training Needed:

- High school diploma or equivalent (strong in math, science, chemistry)
- 1 year Certification/training by Northeast Technology Center.

National Certification:

- Upon successful completion of training and clinical rotation hours, high school graduates may sit for the National Certification Exam (PTCB), which will reward you with the credentials CPhT.
