### Parent/Guardian Statement of Understanding College Credit for High School Students

As the parent/guardian of \_\_\_\_\_, I understand that college credit for technical courses is available through Oklahoma State University at Okmulgee, Rogers State University in Claremore and/or Northeastern Oklahoma A & M College in Miami for high school students enrolled in selected programs at participating Technology Centers. In order to be eligible for admission to and enrollment in these cooperative enrollment credit courses, I understand that high school students must:

- Have an ACT score in the 42<sup>nd</sup> percentile **OR** an ACT Plan score that predicts such student performance (Currently, ACT score of 19, ACT Plan score of 15) **OR** a high school grade point average of 2.5; **AND**;
- Have written support from the student's technology center counselor/advisor;
- Have written parent/guardian consent;
- Once admitted, students must maintain a 2.0 average in their college level courses to remain in good standing and maintain college credit eligibility.

I understand the following items as they relate to college transcripts:

- College credit is granted by participating university through a Cooperative Alliance Enrollment Agreement with Northeast Technology Center.
- Final grades submitted by the instructor at Northeast Technology Center at the end of the college semester will become part of the official college transcript at the chose participating college.
- Credit transcribed by participating college is eligible for transfer to other colleges.
- There will be an \$8.00 per credit hour fee assessed for the Cooperative Alliance credit. This does not apply to the general education courses available through participating colleges. The student will owe full tuition to the provider in these cases.
- If a student does not pay the Cooperative Alliance fee of \$8.00 per credit hour by the deadline established by the participating college, credit may not be awarded.
- Once a student is officially enrolled in a college course, the student must drop that course within the designated time frame in order for the grade not to show on the official transcript.
